THE GERMAN JEWISH AID COMMITTEE

Deals with refugees from Greater Germany (excluding Czechoslovakia) who are Jewish by religion.

Departments of the above Committee:

IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT: All enquiries should be referred to the Personal Enquiries Branch, Bloomsbury House.

TRAINEE DEPARTMENT: Training and Employment cases.

WELFARE DEPARTMENT: Cheap lodgings, offers of hospitality and medical advice.

OVERSEAS SETTLEMENT DEPARTMENT: Advice on emigration to countries overseas.

THE DOMESTIC BUREAU:
